In the Bavona Valley, men have always been able to wisely adapt to an environment where nature has always been powerful. They have restored, built under rocks, and brought dirt on boulders to create lawns or to cultivate vegetables. For centuries, the people of the valley practiced transhumance by building impressive paths towards the most remote alps.

Today the Bavona Valley is situated in a context of extraordinary beauty. It is at the same time alive and an admirable testimony of a rural civilization of the past. Since 1983 it's registered in the federal inventory of landscapes, sites, and monuments of federal importance.

Land management

To preserve such a vast and diversified territory, it is necessary that many people come and work together. In an autonomous way or in collaboration with local authorities, the Foundation also promotes important projects to enhance the landscape.

Landscape Workshop

The Landscape Workshop has two main goals: raising awareness about the value of the traditional rural and alpine landscapes and actively involving the public. As a unique heritage, the Bavona Valley is enhanced through educational and cultural offers for the local population, schools, visitors, and other groups. The Landscape laboratory is supported by the Swiss Heritage Society and the Canton of Ticino.
